Luka Koper operates an international multipurpose port, handling all types of cargo and commodities (except crude oil and gas) at 12 specialised terminals. Total port area is 280 ha with 26 berths on 3,4 km of operative guays. All terminals are directly connected to the EU railway and motorway network. Port's yearly throughput is approx. 24 million tons of various cargo, including more than 1 mio containers (TEU) and 800.000 new finished car units, which makes Port of Koper the largest container terminal in Adriatic and one of the largest car terminals in the Mediterranean, Customs free zone extends over the whole port area. Pre-clearing customs procedure available Central and Eastern European markets can be reached from the Port of Koper by road in less than one day and by train in less than two days. Route is shorter and more sustainable in comparison to some other Northern Adriatic ports.


